



Sketching policy

Sketching is allowed in the Smart Museum of Art's galleries, but for the safety of the artwork, please follow these guidelines:

- Use only graphite pencil or graphite stick in the galleries.
 - No crayon, charcoal, Conté crayon, ink, or chalk is allowed in the gallery spaces. Any dry media however is acceptable for use in the Museum's reception hall. No spray fix is allowed in the Museum building.
- No wet media (e.g. paints) are allowed in the galleries.
- Use only a handheld notebook or sketchpad (no larger than 14 x 17 inches).
- Clipboards may be borrowed from the education department by making arrangements in advance.
- Do not use gallery stools—they are located in the reception hall near the drinking fountain and coat closet.
- Do not use any wall surface, pedestal, or platform to prop up work.
- Do not block passageways in galleries.
